



We are inviting YOU and anyone in our surrounding communities to create art for our fourth annual 6 x 6 Community Art Show. As this is a fundraiser, all art submitted is donated to the center and will be for sale for \$15 each. You don't have to be a member or an artist to participate. In fact, that is what makes it fun because all entries are hung anonymously. No one knows who made the art until it is purchased! Anyone can participate and there is no entry fee. All sales benefit the Salmon River Fine Arts Center.

Not sure what to make? Our January classes will focus on making 6 x 6 art in a variety of mediums!

Participation is free to anyone – no age restrictions.

How it works:

- Artwork will be hung anonymously and assigned a number.
- Artwork available for viewing prior to the opening: Thursday & Friday, Feb 2 - 3.
- VIP Early Purchases (for valued patrons who donated \$100 or more this year).
- All artwork available for \$15 each (first come, first served).
- Upon purchase, the artist's name will be revealed to the buyer.
- A dot will be placed on the tag when artwork is purchased.
- Artwork will remain up until the end of the exhibition.
- Artwork may be purchased throughout the exhibition either online or in person.

Artwork Guidelines:

- All artwork must be exactly six inches square, measured from the outside of the piece including any mat or frame.
- 2-D or 3-D work welcome, any material or media. (Mat or frame not required.)
- Artwork must be ready to hang by hook or push pins. (If using a framed canvas, wire should be installed in the back for a hook.)
- Artwork must be submitted with an entry form, and an artwork tag must be attached to each entry. Download forms and tags from our website.
- Artwork is to be signed only on the back to keep the work anonymous! (The artist's name will be revealed upon purchase.)
- Limit three pieces of artworks per person. If you want them shown together in a certain order, please number the back of the work from left to right.
- Schools may submit three pieces of artwork per grade level. (Teachers can decide criteria for selecting.)
- Artwork will remain on display until the end of the exhibition.
- Any unsold work will be returned to the artists with our thanks after the exhibit! (Artwork not picked up after 30 days become the property of the Salmon River Fine Arts Center.)
