## ELIGIBILITY

Any Oswego County student in grade level 7 through 12 (as of March 2026) may enter. Students can enter independently or through their school or organization – private, public or homeschool.

## ARTWORK CATEGORIES

All media including, but not limited to: Drawing, Painting, Mixed Media, Printmaking, Photography, Digital Art, Animation, Sculpture & Fine Craft (Ceramics, Jewelry, Mosaics, Stained Glass, Textiles, etc.).

## JUDGING AND AWARDS

Works will be judged on originality, technical skill and personal style. Each student will receive a digital certificate for participation. Honorable mentions will be given a ribbon. **Over \$1,500 in Cash prizes will be awarded** including an overall Best of Show for \$100 plus additional Cash awards for two age groups: Grades 10, 11, and 12 AND Grades 7, 8, and 9 in the following categories:

- Drawing, First Place • Second Place • Third Place
- Painting, First Place • Second Place • Third Place
- Mixed Media & Printmaking, First Place • Second Place • Third Place
- Photography, First Place • Second Place • Third Place
- Digital Art & Animation, First Place • Second Place • Third Place
- Sculpture & Fine Craft, First Place • Second Place • Third Place

## GUIDELINES FOR ART

- There is no limit to the number of entries per district
- Each student may submit up to 5 pieces of artwork, any media accepted
- Teachers, please fill out your the digital inventory sheet for your your school
- All artwork must be submitted in physical format by Saturday, March 7th, 2 pm.
- Artwork must be original and of high quality.
- Please use WHITE or BLACK mat only for 2-d art. Please note: Push pins/tape may be used for hanging.
- Please attach provided entry forms to the back of each 2-D piece and the bottom of each 3D piece.
