“Sunday Artists” Art Exhibition Prospectus

About the exhibit:

The “Sunday Artists” show is an annual exhibit featuring original work of amateurs, emerging artists, and semi-professional artists (those not making a livelihood with their art). The purpose of this show is to inspire and give individuals the opportunity to engage with other artists and have their artwork publicly exhibited and professionally judged. This year’s juror will be Amanda Muto (see bio below). This exhibition is hosted by the Salmon River Fine Arts Center, a non-profit 501(c)3 organization in the historic village of Pulaski, NY.

Eligibility and Artwork Guidelines

1. Artists must be 18 years and older.
2. Artwork must be original works by the artist and of high quality. Commercially produced copies and reproductions of original works are not eligible for submission. However, fine art prints such as photographs, lithographs, woodcuts, engravings, etchings, screen prints and digital works are acceptable as long as they are labeled as such and numbered as an edition.
3. All styles and genres accepted in both 2-D and 3-D
4. Artists may enter up to 4 (four) completed works. An effort to display all submitted work will be made, but the number of entries received will dictate the categories and selection process.
5. Artwork may not exceed 3’ in either length or height.
6. All works entered must have been created in the last two years and may not have been previously exhibited in a juried show by The Salmon River Fine Arts Center.
7. Artwork content must be appropriate for all audiences, any submissions we deem inappropriate or offensive in subject matter will be rejected.
8. The Salmon River Fine Arts Center reserves the right to use any submitted work for documentary and publicity purposes.
9. Receipt of the completed entry form constitutes your agreement with all conditions and terms described in the prospectus.

Framing

1. All artwork must be appropriately framed or matted. Works on canvas must be framed or have gallery-wrapped, finished edges with no staples visible.
2. A hanging wire must be firmly attached to the back with screw-eyes or D-rings, and the wire should not exceed the top of the frame. **2-D pieces with saw tooth hangers will not be accepted.**
3. Please Note: 2-D Artworks will be hung from the gallery’s hanging system with a 20 lbs. weight limit. Sculpture should not exceed 50 lbs.

Fees and sales

1. A non-refundable fee of \$5 fee is required per entry for members and \$10 per entry for non-members. Artists may submit up to four entries.
1. Submit entry fee in person when you drop off your work.
2. Items may be listed for sale or NFS (not for sale.) The gallery will handle all sales transactions collecting and remitting appropriate sales tax.
1. A 30% contribution to the Salmon River Fine Arts Center will be deducted from each sale. A check to the artists for gallery sales will be mailed within 5 days of the month end of the month the sale was made.
3. All items sold must remain on display through the end of the exhibit date.

Submission Procedure

1. Artwork must be delivered in person during business hours (Thursday & Friday: Noon - 6 PM, Saturday: 10 AM - 2 PM), to the Salmon River Fine Arts Center at 4848 N Jefferson St, Pulaski, by the deadline listed above.
2. All artwork must have a completed entry form taped to the back of the artwork.
3. The following additional information, although optional, will help us better present and market your artwork. Please submit this information via email to sr.fine.arts.ctr@gmail.com
 - For each artwork submitted please include a brief description.
 - Please include a brief artist statement or biography that may be used in promoting “our artists” in the gallery, or possibly on social media.

Judging and Awards

Work is judged on originality and creativity, aesthetic quality and visual impact, technical skills and craftsmanship. Cash prizes will be awarded. First, second, and third place cash awards will be given for both 2-D categories and 3-D categories. Additional prizes will be determined on the number of entries received.

About the Juror



Amanda Muto has a bachelor’s degree in studio art from Oswego State and an Art Education degree from Nazareth College of Rochester. As well as being an artist she manages the marketing for her family’s dairy business, as well as a few local modern restaurants and is currently working on illustrating a children’s book. Amanda has instructed and critiqued art, and loves to incorporate her painting, drawing, photography and graphics in her daily life as a dairy farmer, mother and marketer. Amanda credits her family upbringing for her many creative passions, saying “I grew up on a farm with my hands in the dirt and sweat on my brow, a wholesome childhood that induced imagination and creativity.”
